
BENEFITS OF Hyperbaric Oxygen

There are several benefits associated with intermittent exposure to hyperbaric doses of oxygen. Oxygen partial pressures in the blood can be elevated to 2000 mmHg at the tissue level. Either alone, or more commonly in combination with other medical and surgical procedures, these mechanisms serve to enhance the healing process of treatable conditions. This treatment will cause the following:

- An increase in the distance which oxygen diffuses from functional capillaries into hypo-perfused wounds. This results in angiogenesis, which enables healing in bone grafts, skin grafts, selected problem wounds, compromised grafts and radiation induced injury.
- Rapidly dissociates carbon monoxide molecules from hemoglobin and dramatically increases amounts of physically dissolved oxygen in the blood for delivery to the tissues.

- Inhibited microbial growth, deactivated bacterial toxins and enhanced white blood cell function in necrotizing infections, and in both osteomyelitis and soft tissue infections that have not responded to conventional therapies.
- Enhances osteoclast and osteoblast function in bone remodeling
- Vasoconstriction and a subsequent decrease in tissue edema resulting from crush injury and compartment syndrome. At the same time, the high oxygen content of the blood overcomes the effects of hypoxia and peripheral ischemia.


